COMPETITION FORMAT

The netball competition will take place in the form of a mini championship where the six **(6)** teams will all compete in a round-robin format.

The teams will be placed into a single group and each team will face the other 5 teams in the group only once. There will be a total of 15 matches, after which, the team with the most points at the end of their five matches will be awarded the gold medal; the team with the second highest points will be awarded the silver medal; the team with the third highest points will be awarded the bronze medal.

QUOTA

According to the quota established by CANOC, the netball competition will have a maximum of seventy-two (72) female athletes and eighteen (18) accompanying staff or twelve players (12) and three (3) coaching staff per team.

AGE OF ATHLETES

To participate in this U23 competition, athletes must not be 23 years of age on **January 1st, 2022**, the year of the competition.

REGISTRATION

All countries, through their respective National Olympic Committee (NOC), must send their Sports' registration applications on the official forms that the Organizing Committee will send no later than 00h.00 (Guadeloupe time) on **January 30, 2022**. The sports in which they will participate in the Caribbean Games "Guadeloupe 2022" must be indicated.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

All countries, through their respective NOC, must send their registration requests on the official forms which the Organizing Committee will send in due course.

The digital registration forms (indicating the number of participants in each team event) must be sent to the organizing committee of the 1st Caribbean Games Guadeloupe 2022 on or before the deadline date: before midnight (Guadeloupe time), **March 30, 2022**.

NOMINAL AND FINAL ENTRIES REGISTRATION

In order, for each eligible athlete to participate in the 1st Caribbean Games Guadeloupe 2022, a nominative registration form must be completed.

These forms must be completed by the NOCs and sent to the organizing committee before midnight (Guadeloupe time) **May 30, 2022**.

Each NOC will have to send its digital entry and personal entry forms on the official forms provided by the organizing committee, which will be sent 6 months before the Games (Jan 2022). PARTICIPATION

Only the NOCs recognized by CANOC, whose national netball federations are affiliated to Americas Netball can register athletes in the netball competition of the 1st Caribbean Games, Guadeloupe 2022.

EVENT

There will be only one **(1)** female competition.

QUALIFICATION

As the host country, Guadeloupe is automatically qualified for the competition.

The official ranking of World Netball, as of June 30, 2021, will be used to determine the five (5) teams that will participate alongside Guadeloupe in the Netball competition of the 1st Caribbean Games 2022:

- JAMAICA
- Trinidad and Tobago
- BARBADOS
- SAINT-LUCIA
- SAINT-VINCENT-AND-THE-GRENADINES

AWARDS

The prizes will be awarded in accordance with the regulations of Chapter XIX of CANOC:

- a) To the winning team a diploma and a gold medal and a diploma to all players
- b) To the team ranked second a diploma and a silver medal and a diploma to all players
- c) To the team ranked third a diploma and a bronze medal and a diploma to all players

d) From fourth to sixth place, a diploma for each athlete and team officials

ANTIDOPING

The Caribbean Games Anti-Doping regulations are prepared by the CANOC Medical and Anti-Doping Commission in conjunction with the Caribbean RADO and reviewed by WADA.

ON-SITE SUPPORT

The Organizing Committee will bear the onsite logistic costs (accommodation, meals, transportation) of the delegations from **June 27 to July 4, 2022.**

Please contact us if you would like an earlier arrival /late departure so that we can help with your extra stay if necessary. Note that all additional costs before and after the dates that will fall under the responsibility of the CG 2022 are the full responsibility of your delegation.

PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION FEES

1. Delegation Registration Fee by Sport

Each NOC must pay LOC, twenty-five US Dollars (25.00 USD) per sport in which it shall participate in respect of rights of registration for the Games.

2. Registration Fee per Participant

Each NOC must pay to the LOC, a per capita fee of five US Dollars (5.00 USD) per participant registered for the Games.

3. Fee for Accommodation and Food

Each NOC must pay fifteen US Dollars (15.00 USD) daily as a fee for Accommodation and Food for each participant that will reside in the Village as a member of its delegation. The days of stay shall be counted from the moment that each member checks into the designated Village up to the day of check-out.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS TO GET IN GUADELOUPE*

Foreign citizens can travel to the French Overseas Territories depending on their vaccination status and the health situation of their country.

To date, the classification of the country is as follows:

- **"Green"** countries / territories: countries / territories in which no active circulation of the virus is observed, and no variants of concern have been identified. These are the countries of the European area, to which are added Saudi Arabia, Australia, Bahrain, Brunei, Canada, Chile, the Comoros, South Korea, Hong Kong, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, New Zealand, Singapore, Taiwan, Ukraine, Uruguay, and Vanuatu.
- **"Orange"** countries / territories: countries / territories in which active circulation of the virus is observed in controlled proportions. These are all countries / territories that are not included in the lists of "green" and "red" countries / territories.
- **"Red"** countries / territories: countries / territories in which active circulation of the virus is observed with the presence of variants of concern. These are the following countries / territories: Afghanistan, South Africa, Algeria, Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Georgia, Indonesia, Iran, Maldives, Morocco, Mozambique, Namibia,

Nepal, Pakistan, Democratic Republic of Congo, Russia, Seychelles, Suriname, Tunisia, and Turkey.

The control rules that are applied to travelers derive from common law and depend on the categorization of the country:

Ø for "green" countries, a negative **PCR test of less than 72 hours** or a **negative antigen test of less than 48 hours** is required for all passengers. In addition, IF you are NOT FULLY VACCINATED, you will also need a **7-day prophylactic isolation commitment**.

Ø for "orange" countries, a negative **PCR test of less than 72 hours** or a **negative antigen test of less than 48 hours** is required for all passengers. In addition, IF you are NOT FULLY VACCINATED, you will also need a **compelling reason, duly justified** according to a pre-established list, and a **7-day prophylactic isolation commitment**.

Ø for the "red" countries with high circulation of the virus, no resumption of traffic. The resumption of international air and sea links is linked to the commitment of companies (air and sea) to carry out checks on compliance with the conditions to be met by passengers before their departure.
